REVIVING A COMMUNITY

ROUTE 66 AND THE BARN

Route 66 and the Round Barn share a critical historic connection, relying heavily on the visual of the Barn from the road. For the revival project, this connection was kept. All the new buildings are located behind the barn to the northeast.

REIGNITING MAIN STREET

Historic Arcadia had a busy downtown strip on Main Street. This old Main Street is revived through a loaded corridor of buildings, from a music store and a pub and restaurant, to Stopover Housing and a field for festivals.

FORMING A COMMUNITY

With new entertainment spaces like a beer garden and amphitheater, along with a new complex of buildings next to Route 66 and the Barn, a community of festivals and music sessions is revived in Arcadia, all while keeping careful attention to its history and culture through local materials and humble constructions.
